1 Introduction




3.1 Create Account




To create an account you must supply your name and password. You must use letters and numbers only for the password (no special characters). Your name can contain spaces.

3.2 Delete Account

You may also delete an account by supplying the name and password of the account. But note that your chats with other users are preserved should these users wish them to remain so.



3.3 Display messenger




Provide the name of a valid account to open a messenger browser tab.

4 Instant messaging

4.1 Messenger window

Hitting the Display messenger button opens the users Messenger window in the Browser:






The messenger window open (that is which user) is indicated by the name of the user below the introductory sentence.

Using the **Add friend** button together with the account name of someone else (it must be a valid account name) adds a 'friend' link to the left-hand menu. This is someone you can chat to.

If the friend which you have added has not also added, you as a friend, then an invitation will be sent to this friend's messenger window. Adding this friend adds the friend to the left-hand menu and removes the invite.

4.2 Chat window

Hitting the link to a friend opens the user-friend chat window between the user and the friend:





The user and the friend are indicated sequentially by the two names beneath the introductory sentence. Here it is possible to communicate with the friend by adding a comment using the **Add a comment** button. If the friend has added the user as a friend also the comment will be displayed in the friend's frienduser chat window and vice versa.

Only two people that have mutually added the other person as a friend can chat.
